

EIRE SCHOOL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

General Terms and Conditions

- Full fees must be paid up to 14 days prior to course commencement
- No refunds are given for courses cancelled within 7 days of course start date
- A €75 cancellation fee applies when courses are cancelled within more than 7 days of course start date.
- Strictly no refunds once course has commenced.
- Courses are non-transferable and must be completed within the dates booked.
- In the case of missed classes due to students going on holiday, personal happenings (any unexpected or unpredictable family events) work, medical reasons, unpredictable events such as bus strikes, Luas strikes, train strikes, heavy traffic, failure to find a parking space near the school, rain, snow, wind, bad weather, etc. unfortunately no refund applies, no classes are compensated for and students cannot attend courses at a later date to make up for unattended classes.
- The centre reserves the right to dismiss a student if in its opinion, the student behaves inappropriately- i.e. verbal or physical aggressiveness or any other hostile behaviour towards teacher or other staff or students and no refund will be given and there are no exceptions.

Other Fees:

- €20 administration fee applies to all courses which covers course registration and materials
- If you require an official letter from the school, a fee of €25 will apply.

One to One classes

- Individual classes (one to one) may be rescheduled with **24 hours' notice, otherwise class is forfeited.**
- Strictly no refunds for unattended/missed classes or once course have commenced. This includes late arrival and early departure.
- All individual classes (one to one) must be completed within the 4 week payment period. However, if the teacher is unable to give a class at the scheduled day/time, the class will be rescheduled for a later date.
- Individual classes can be **rescheduled a maximum of 1 time with at least 24 hours' notice. If there is less than 24 hours' notice given, the class is forfeited.**
- In the case of missed classes due to students going on holiday without notifying the school, personal happenings (any unexpected or unpredictable family events) work, medical reasons or unpredictable events such as bus strikes, Luas strikes, train strikes, heavy traffic, failure to find a parking space near the school, rain, snow, bad weather, unfortunately no refund applies, no classes are compensated for and students cannot attend courses at a later date to make up for unattended classes.
